

Biography – Hon. Justice John Gerald Farouk Carey



Hon. Justice John Carey has over 32 years' experience in the public and private sectors in the Caribbean and the Pacific Islands. He is a Justice of the National and Supreme Courts of Papua New Guinea and the Judge Administrator and Board Secretary for the Papua New Guinea Centre for Judicial Excellence (PNGCJE) based in Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea. In this role, Justice Carey is responsible for Judicial Education and Training of Judges, Magistrates, Court staff and the provision of continuing professional development opportunities for the law and justice sector in 15 countries in the Pacific Islands. Justice Carey is Co-opted Council Member of the Commonwealth Magistrates and Judges Association and a member of the Asia-Pacific Judicial Educators Association. He also serves on the Advisory Board of the Commonwealth Judicial Education Institute in Halifax, Canada. He is the author of five books, *When your Back's Against the Wall* (co-authored with his father), *Political Speeches from the Bahamas*, *National Discourse: Bahamian Perspective*, *Taxation: The Suitability of the Non-Direct Tax Regime for the Cayman Islands* and *Political Discourses*. . Justice Carey has visited more than 90 villages in Papua New Guinea and conducted Community Awareness on Access to Justice and Basic Rights for citizens.
